1. WEEE DIRECTIVE & REGULATORY ALIGNMENT



Verify Waste Carrier upper-Tier Licencing

Prepare Waste Transfer Notes (WTN)

Ensure a formal Waste Transfer Note is prepared for execution at the point of handoff, carrying the appropriate European Waste Catalogue (EWC) codes for electrical equipment waste.



Isolate Hazardous Chemical and Battery Compounds

Separate stand-alone consumables, large printer toners, and leaking laptop lithium-ion batteries. These are classified as hazardous waste streams under environmental oversight codes.

2. DATA DESTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS



Execute Certified Multi-Pass Data Wiping

Utilize verified software algorithms to purge functional hard drives (HDDs) and solid-state drives (SSDs), satisfying UK data governance rules before systems leave the building.



Isolate Faulty storage Devices for Physical Shredding

Clearly tag and segregate dead or non-functional hard drives. These must be physically crushed, shredded, or degaussed to remove information leak vectors.



Mandate Serialized Certificates of Destruction

Specify that your disposal partner must issue individual, timestamped Certificates of Destruction (COD) mapped directly to device serial tracking strings.

3. COMPREHENSIVE ASSET TRACKING LOGS



Compile a Master Decommission Manifest

Log model descriptions, manufacturer names, asset tracking stickers, and internal unique hardware parameters to anchor your business's legal chain of custody records.

**Clear Enterprise Domain MDM Hardware Tags**

De-authorize and remove retiring endpoints from organizational Mobile Device Management (MDM) groups, corporate networks, and software licensing servers.

4. ON-SITE COLLECTION PREPARATION

**Secure Logistics and Loading Cages**

Pack loose IT assets securely into locked, rolling security containers rather than un-anchored open pallets. This minimizes hardware damage risks or accidental loss during load out shifts.

**Coordinate Verified Loading Bay Sign-Off**

Verify courier badges against identity logs before allowing equipment load out. Sign off matching manifests directly with transport drivers to formalize regional tracking transfers.

Protect Institutional Accountability and Reduce Corporate Waste Liabilities.

Deploy this reference template during asset decommissioning to satisfy environmental duty of care rules, secure enterprise data boundaries, and support verifiable ESG carbon footprint logging tracks.
